COVID-19 VACCINE RECOMMENDATIONS 6 MONTHS-18 YEARS

Primary Series 2 doses + 2 boosters. World Health Organization recommends for high-risk populations. CDC recommends for ALL children. **NOT** required for Texas children.

2025 TEXAS IMMUNIZATION RECOMMENDATIONS FOR K-12

Dtap/Tdap	K-6th 7th 8th - 12th	5 doses or 4 doses 3 dose primary series and 1 Tdap/Td booster within last 5 years 3 dose primary series and 1 Tdap/Td booster within last 10 years
Polio	K-12th	4 doses or 3 doses
MMR	K-12th	2 dose
Hep B	K-12th	3 doses
Varicella	K-12th	2 dose
Hep A	K-10th	2 dose
Meningococcal	7th-12th	1 dose
